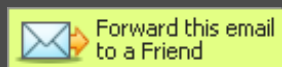

PRODUCTION ACTIVITY

The first part of the year was extremely busy and with the wind-down of

some shows comes the gearing up of others. *Longmire* (season 3) and *Blood Father* have wrapped, as will *Manhattan* in the near future. Meanwhile, two more television series are likely to start prep shortly for fall production while the *Better Call Saul* series and summer features *Sicario* and *In the Valley of Violence* continue their productions. Five low budget indies are in process with two more likely to land in the fall.

The final season of [Breaking Bad](#) earned 16 nominations, to include Best Outstanding Drama Series! Bryan Cranston is up for Outstanding Lead Actor in a Drama Series, Anna Gunn for Outstanding Supporting Actress in a Drama Series, and Aaron Paul for Outstanding Supporting Actor in a Drama Series.

AND congratulations to all the New Mexicans nominated for their work on *Breaking Bad* - Kiira Arai (Casting Director), nominated for Outstanding Casting for a Drama Series; Darryl L. Frank (Production Mixer), nominated for Outstanding Sound Mixing for a Comedy or Drama Series; Tarra Day (Department Head Makeup Artist) and Corey Welk (Key Makeup Artist), nominated for Outstanding Makeup for a Single-Camera Series (Non-Prosthetic)
