SANTA FE —New Mexico Film Office Director Nick Maniatis announced today that the television series “Better Call Saul”, produced by Sony Pictures Television and starring Bob Odenkirk (“Breaking Bad,” “ Fargo”) will be filmed in Albuquerque, NM.

“What could be better than having Sony and AMC bring ‘Better Call Saul’ back to Albuquerque, hiring our local crew and vendors,” said Mayor Richard Berry.

The production will employ at least 75-90 New Mexico crewmembers.
