

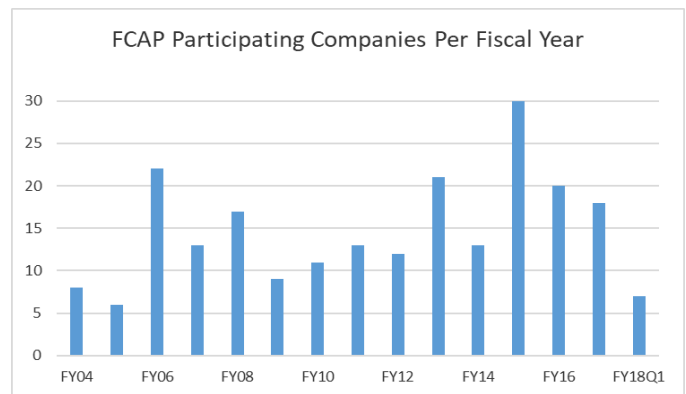
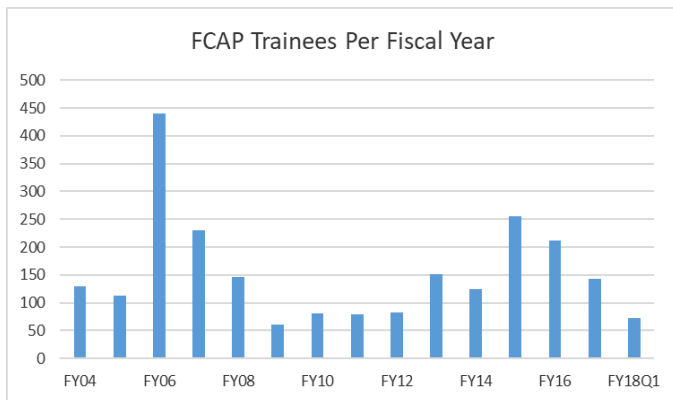
Film Crew Advancement Program (FCAP)

Through the Economic Development Department Job Training Incentives Program (JTIP) for film and multimedia, the NMFO supports economic development in New Mexico by providing training opportunities to New Mexico below-the-line crew.

Since FY04 – FY18 Q1, 220 companies have participated with 2318 New Mexico trainees.

Pre-Employment Training Program (PETP)

2006 - YTD

The Pre-Employment Training Program (PETP) was developed by NMFO to assist New Mexico's economy by providing reimbursement funds to contractors facilitating short-term intensive workshops and lectures that primarily relate to below-the-line film and television job positions. The program objective is to increase the hirability of New Mexicans for continual employment in the film and television industry.

Since FY06, twenty-nine (29) interactive workshops and lectures have taken place with six hundred and thirty-two (632) New Mexico participants. Total reimbursement is \$151,622.42.
