The New Mexico Film Office Announces "Land of Dreams" to film in New Mexico

Santa Fe, N.M. – The New Mexico State Film Office Director Todd Christensen announced today that the short "Land of Dreams" produced by Land of Dreams LLC & Hardline Films, will begin principal photography in June, shooting through mid-June in Algodones, Las Vegas and Shiprock.

The production will employ 25 New Mexico crew members, 9 New Mexico actors and 150 New Mexico background talent.

The short is directed by Shirin Neshat and co-produced by Sol Tryon and Shoja Azari.

Starring Sheila Vand ("A Girl Walks Home Alone at Night," "Argo," "We the Animals") and Mohammad Ghaffari ("The Devil's Advocate," "Little Odessa"), "Land of Dreams" is about a young Iranian-American woman who is making an art project by photographing average Americans and recording their dreams. She drives to another land and enters into a mysterious Iranian Colony nestled in a mountainous desert. There she works to circumvent the system they have in place for interpreting the dreams she has been collecting.
