The series tracks their stumbling ambitions, and explores how relationships between friends and family evolve as the reality of your dreams starts to hit. It's a sloppy celebration of life in the suburban southwest.

The pilot will be directed by Chris Storer, with executive producers Mehar Sethi, Ash Atalla and Jon Petrie from Roughcut TV, and Chris Storer.
