

The New Mexico Film Office Announces “Junkyard” to film in New Mexico

Santa Fe, N.M. - New Mexico Film Office announced today that the feature “Junkyard,” produced by Busy Day Productions and Dark Road Pictures will begin principal photography late January through the end of May in Santa Fe and Albuquerque.

The production will employ approximately 48 New Mexico crew members, 47 New Mexico actors and 93 New Mexico background talent.

Directed by Zoltan Hodi and produced by Tamas Nadas (“Fierce Target”), Daniel "DC" Casillas (“NM Slaughter House”) and Rian Bishop (“Busy Day”). The feature stars Danny Casillas (“Battlefield Apocalypse”), Ryan Federico (“Love Thy Neighbor”), Tamas Nadas (“Fierce Target”), Zoltan Hodi (“Madam Secretary”), Stephen Goldfield (“Fierce Target”), and Michael Laurin (“Cry in the Night”).

“Junkyard” is the story of two twin baby brothers who get separated in Afghanistan in 1981, when an airstrike hits their home. Both survive, 38 years later they meet again by accident as enemies.
