The New Mexico Film Office Announces “Houseboat Amazon: Search for a Missing Monkey” to film in New Mexico

Santa Fe, N.M. – The New Mexico State Film Office Director Todd Christensen announced today that the documentary “Houseboat Amazon: Search for a Missing Monkey,” produced by Hear Kitty Studios and Houseboat Amazon LLC will begin principal photography mid-August in Albuquerque and Santa Fe.

The production will employ 4 New Mexico crew members and 1 New Mexico actor.

The documentary is directed and produced by Laura K Marsh and Kathleen Edwards along with co-producers Tor Kingdon.

Starring Dr. Laura K. Marsh, “Houseboat Amazon: Search for a Missing Monkey is set in January through May 2017, a woman led scientific expedition – with a research team from US, Brazil, Colombia and Mexico, a Brazilian boat crew, and 135 local guides – explored a remote Amazonian watershed while living on a houseboat, searching five rivers along the Alto Rio Jurua in Brazil to find missing "flying" saki monkeys that had not been seen alive by science in over 80 years.
