

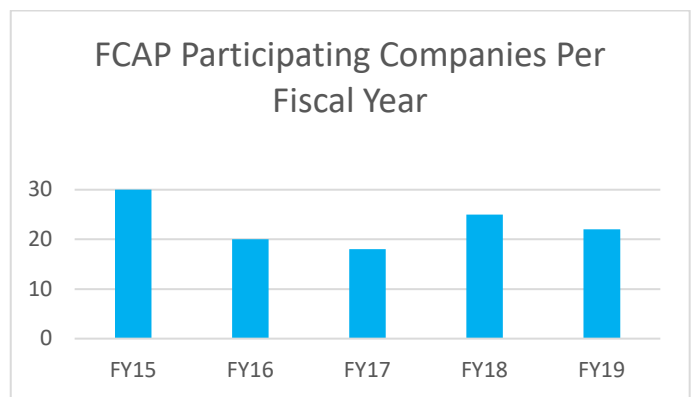
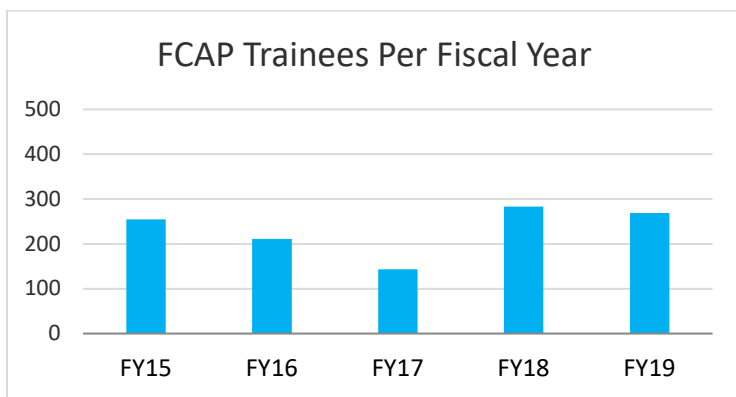

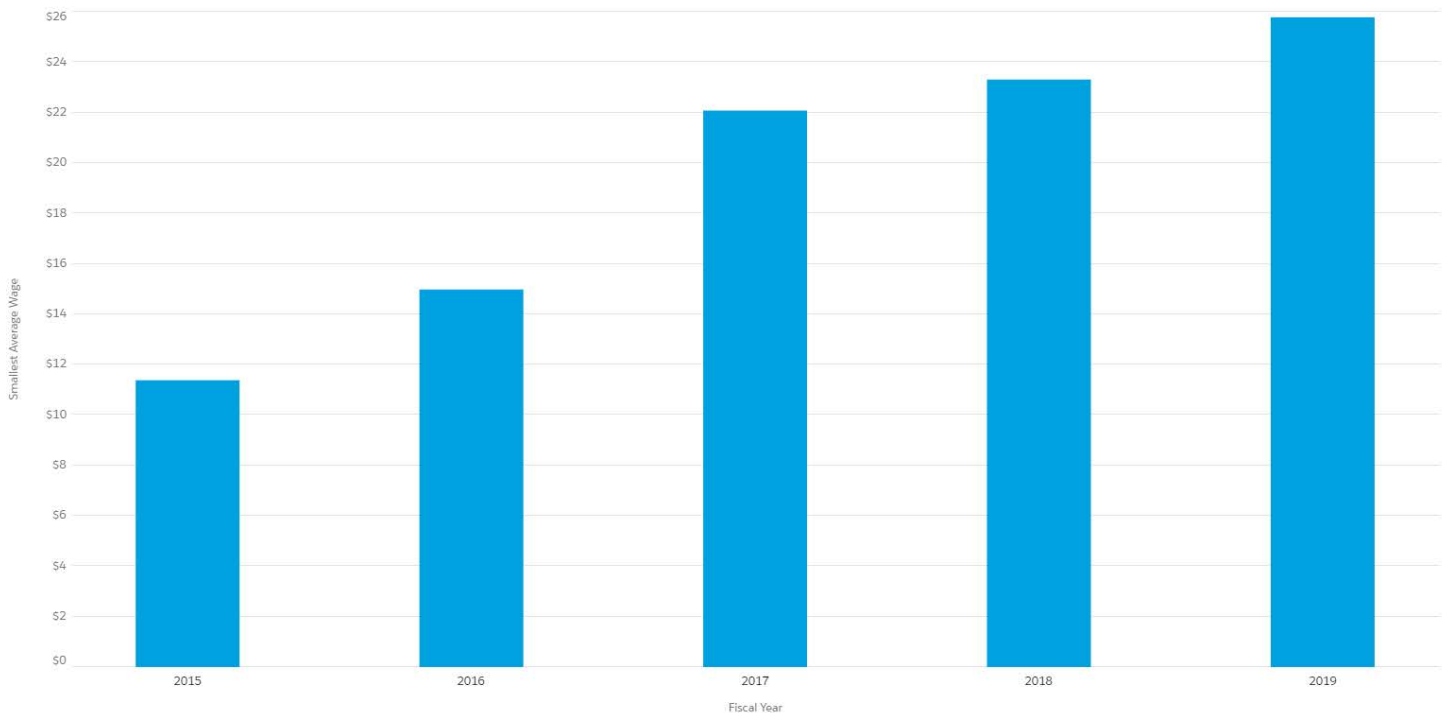

The average wage of trainees for FY19 = \$24.46.*

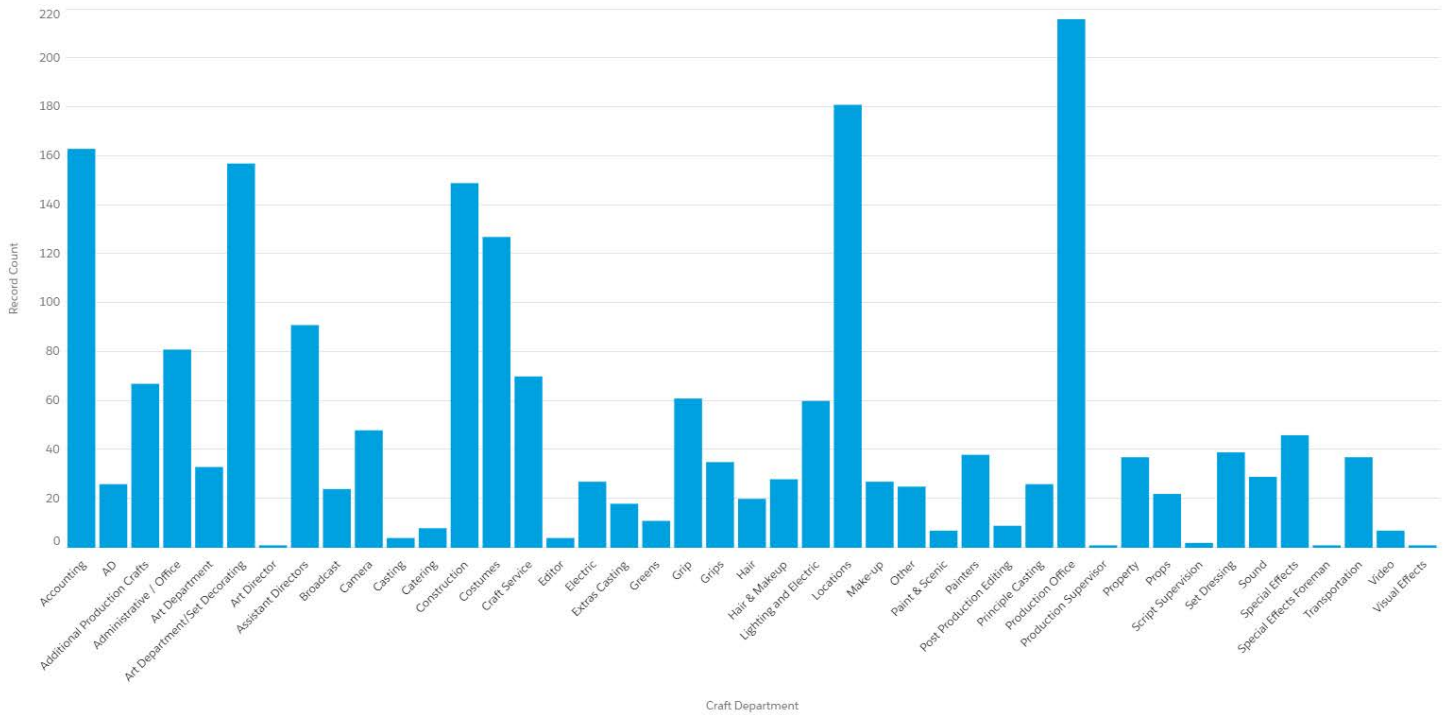

**Pre-Employment Training Program (PETP) 2006 - YTD**

The Pre-Employment Training Program (PETP) was developed by NMFO to assist New Mexico's economy by providing reimbursement funds to contractors facilitating short-term intensive workshops and lectures that primarily relate to below-the-line film and television job positions. The program objective is to increase the hirability of New Mexicans for continual employment in the film and television industry.

*Since FY06, twenty-nine (29) interactive workshops and lectures have taken place with six hundred and thirty-two (632) New Mexico participants. Total reimbursement is \$151,622.42.*
